

About Us



The Auburn Valley Humane Society is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization who partners with the City of Auburn for the housing of the lost and stray animals within the City of Auburn. The AVHS shelter opened on January 1, 2013. AVHS also serves King and Pierce County for pet

adoptions and owners looking to re-home their beloved pets.

Since we opened January 1, 2013 through September, 2016, animals that came into our care at AVHS include:

- 2,938 Dogs and puppies
- 3,465 Cats and kittens
- 172 Bunnies, birds and other critters
- 82 injured or displaced wildlife

Animals that left our care at AVHS include:

- 2,770 Dogs and puppies
- 3,327 Cats and kittens
- 168 Bunnies, birds and other critters
- 76 injured or displaced wildlife

The live release rate at Auburn Valley Humane Society, is 97%, however, we do not describe our organization as a "no-kill" shelter. NO adoptable animals have been euthanized since we opened in January, 2013.

As of October, 2016, volunteers have generously donated over 100,000 hours of their time helping save homeless and abandoned animals in our community.

AVHS Girl Scout Patch Program

The AVHS Girl Scout Patch Program consists of four levels: Daisy, Brownie, Junior and Cadette/Senior.



- At each level, girls participate in a variety of age appropriate activities teaching them about pet responsibility including a tour of the AVHS shelter.

The Girl Scout patch program has a fee of \$10 per scout. Your \$500 sponsorship will subsidize 100 girl scouts in the program. Scholarship opportunities are available upon request.

Shelter Buddies Reading Program

The **Shelter Buddies Reading Program** is designed for children in grades K-6, to read to the shelter cats in designated cat colony rooms.

- The animals receive human contact in a relaxing, comfortable environment that helps socialize them while the children practice their reading skills.
- Children will earn prizes for every five 30-minute reading sessions.

Seniors for Seniors Program

The AVHS **Seniors for Seniors Program** offers waived adoption fees and city licensing to senior citizens living in the city limits of Auburn, Washington.

The adoption program is all about senior citizens re-discovering the joys of having a cat or dog in their lives and the benefits it brings. The program places senior cats and senior dogs (typically over 7 years of age) with senior citizens, who are 62 years of age or older living in the city of Auburn.
